Embassy of Japan in Bosnia and Herzegovina is pleased to announce that the Summer Japanese Language Program will be held at the Philosophy Faculty of University of Sarajevo in **September** 2019. The Program offers the opportunity to learn Japanese language and culture with the aim to contribute to the building of friendship between the people of BiH and Japan. The Program is organized within the framework of a collaborative agreement between University of Sarajevo, BiH and Sophia University (上智大学), Tokyo, Japan, and supported by the Japan Embassy in BiH.

The Program is practice-oriented and provides participants with the opportunity to experience Japanese culture. It offers **5** courses of different levels from very beginners to more advanced. Each course consists of 9 classes over the period of three weeks. The program also offers **1** optional course for participants who are interested in very advanced speaking skill. ## **♦** Course Description

Beginner A	This course is designed for students who have never learnt Japanese before. Students			
Beginner B	will learn basic phrases in Japanese, daily conversation and also the Japanese writing			
(Ms.Matsushita)	system: Kana (Japanese letters: such as あいうアイウ) and Kanji(漢字).			
	Students will learn not only Japanese language but also Japanese culture. Some Japanese			
	cultural activities (for example: Origami (Japanese paper folding), Japanese sweet			
	Japanese traditional game, etc.) will be offered.			
Japanese 1.1	This course is designed for students who have learnt Japanese for less than a year or			
(after beginner)	who have taken our Beginner course last year. The aim of this course is to learn basic			
(Ms.Takano)	phrases in Japanese and daily conversation. This course also introduces Japanese culture			
	and will offer some Japanese cultural experience.			
Japanese 1.2	This course is designed for students whose Japanese level is between beginner and			
(pre -	intermediate. The aim of this course is to brush up speaking and listening skills. Students will			
intermediate)	learn Japanese phrases used in ordinary situations through conversational practices. This			
(Mr.Kawahara)	course is aimed at students in the Level 1 of regular Japanese course or who have			
	learnt Japanese for more than a year and know basic Japanese grammar. The			
	knowledge of the Japanese writing system (Hiragana and Katakana) is required.			

Japanese 2
(intermediate)
(Ms.Takano)

This course is designed for people who have already learnt basic knowledge of Japanese. The aim of this class is to enhance students' conversational skills in many practical situations. In this class, students will have a lot of opportunities to speak about various topics (especially Japanese and Bosnian cultures). Also, some opportunities to improve students' Japanese listening comprehension skill will be provided. This class is designed for students who are in the Level 2 or 3 of regular Japanese Course or whose level is intermediate.

# Japanese 3 (upper intermediate) (Mr.Kawahara)

This course is designed for students who have basic knowledge of Japanese and can have a conversation in some daily situations. The aim of this course is to enable students to talk about not only daily subjects but also less familiar ones in Japanese. In this course, we will deal with various topics through many activities such as discussion, presentation and so on. The class activities could change in response to student's needs and interest. This course is designed for students who are in the Level 3 or 4 of regular Japanese course or whose level is upper - intermediate.
