Recognition at University of Sarajevo	<p>Before departure, outgoing students obtain the signatures of the relevant professors at their home institution confirming their approval for the recognition of the courses selected at the partner university. After receiving the Transcript of Records from the partner institution, students must translate the document and submit it to the Student Service of the Faculty. The International Academic Cooperation Office and the Vice-Dean then initiate the recognition procedure based on the professors' prior approval.</p> <p>In adherence to the European Charter for Higher Education, the Vice-Dean and Departmental Coordinator are obliged to actively encourage academics to fully recognize exams successfully completed during the mobilities. To formalize this process, the International Relations Office and the Vice-Dean generate Table D – After the Mobility, documenting successfully completed exams. Any exams that cannot be recognized or participation in summer schools are added to the Diploma Supplement as free facultative subjects. This comprehensive process typically requires a minimum of one month.</p>

	<p>Upon the staff's return from mobility, they have the opportunity to present at least one good practice learned during the mobility. Staff members are encouraged to write a report and submit it to the Head of the Department to which they belong. The involved departments include Vice-Dean for International Academic Cooperation, Office for International Academic Cooperation, the Department specified in the Erasmus+ Agreement, Departmental Coordinator, and the Student Service.</p>
